



Having problems logging into the PWAC Website Members Area



Solutions for resolving the Scripted Pages issue with the PWAC website

Option 1 – temporary solution the simple solution – you will need to do this every time you access the members area in a web session When it tells you that you have the wrong password it probably also gives you a line just above the website and below the toolbar saying. **This website is using a scripted window to ask you for information. If you trust this website click here to allow scripted windows....** If that's the case click on that line and it'll bring up a box that says temporarily allowed scripted windows, click on that then hit the PWAC Members button again and it should ask you for your password. Then enter the **password** and you should get in. This will have to be done everytime you enter a new session on your pc.

Option 2 - permanent solution but it's a bit more complicated :- When you are in an Internet Explorer page click on the Tools button in the top right hand corner of the screen, then select Internet Options, then select Security (make sure internet is highlighted, the globe) then click custom level button, scroll down to scripting (it's near the bottom of the list), go to the fourth item labelled "Allow websites to prompt for information using scripted windows" click the enable button, then click OK. It may ask you to click the Apply button. That should allow you just to input the **password** every time you hit Members Page option on the PWAC website.
